For bravery in beating off a counterattack, and sticking to a post about thirty yards in front of our lines, until given orders to withdraw from his post. He was the only man left from a whole Lewis gun team, but kept the gun in action, inflicting many casualties on the enemy.

Bar to Military Medal

London Gazette, March 13th 1918 Action Date, November 20th 1917 – Cambrai

He displayed great courage and determination. When some of his team were knocked out he carried forward his gun and four carriers and single handed brought his gun into action under very heavy machine gun fire. His action in affording covering fire enabled the advance to continue.
