

It is noted that you require information concerning sending money or parcels to your son who is a prisoner of war in Germany. I am directed to inform you that parcels of fock at a rate of three per fortnight are forwarded regularly from the date a man is reported as a prisoner. Parcels of clothing are forwarded at stated periods. While a soldier is a prisoner of war his pay continues to be credited to his account at the Pay & Record Office London. Regulations allow 10s.per month to be forwarded and a soldier requiring money should write to the Pay & Record Office, London, outlining his needs.

The Newfoundland War Contingent Association is very painstaking over sending parcels and every thing possible is done always for the welfare of prisoners of war.




