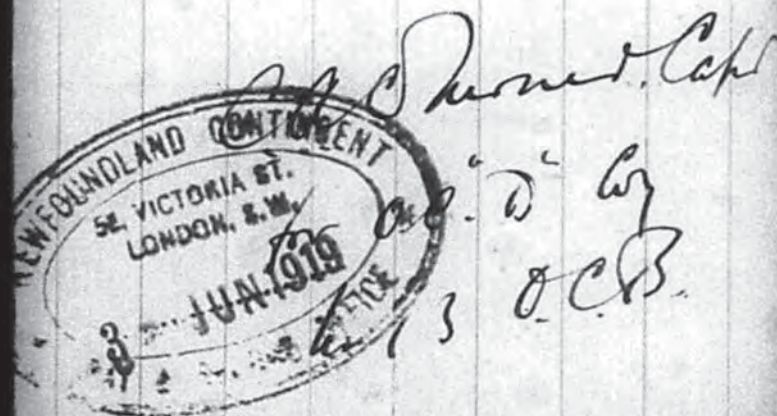

Re clause 14; the only definite statement I can make is that I received a cheque for \$103.46 which I deposited at the Bank of Canada on May 3rd 1919. This is the last payment I received & was, to the best of my knowledge, composed of Back-pay, Ration allowance & gratuity, the gratuity being at a sergeant's rate of pay. I received one or two small payments previous to this but of these I have no record whatever.

In view of the fact that I am unable to give a definite answer to the above clause, clause 19 and one or two others which are based on these, I shall hold over the form I have received until I hear from your department.

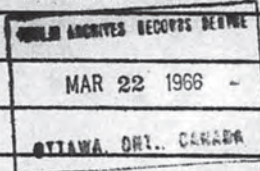
