Dear Mr. Squires:- Re No. 4342 Stanley Atkins

In reply to your letter of March 18th concerning the above mentioned ex soldier, I would state that his services with the Royal Naval Reserve cannot be taken into account in the granting of War Service Gratuity, as he was discharged from the Navy, services no longer required. For his period of service with the Royal Newfoundland Regiment he was entitled to receive, and has received, four payments of \$70.00 each.

I am informed by the Board of Pension Commissioners that his pension is \$10.00 per month, and he is due for reboard on May 1st, 1920.

This man applied for a course and was granted one in carpentry on April 17th, 1919 which he voluntarily relinquished on May 5th, 1919. He applied on August 18th for a course in motor engineering and the application was refused, for the reason that he had given up his previous course of his own deliberation, and a second course under these circumstances may not be granted.

OPINION OF THE MEDICAL BOARD.

NOTES.—(i) Clear and definite answers are to be filled in by the Board, as, in the event of a man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

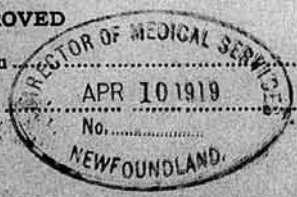



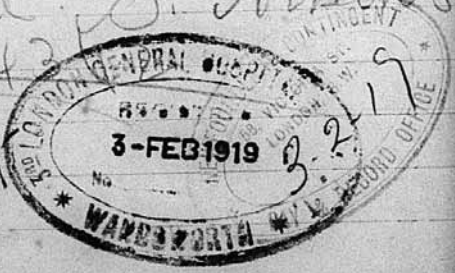
