Dear Sir:-

When at Grand Falls recently I had the pleasure of meeting you, and received from you a complaint, as I understood it, regarding receipt of your War Service Gratuity Cheques, and I accepted the complaint in good faith, and made a note to look up the matter when I came to town. On investigation I am very sorry to learn that your complaint is absolutely groundless. I understood from you that you had not received Gratuity since May, yet I find I mailed two (2) cheques to you at Grand Falls on the 15th July, and that on the 7th August, You called for and received cheque dated August 3rd., the next cheque following these would be payable on the 3rd September, and in the ordinary course of events would not be forwarded before September 7th or 31 days after you received the previous one. I feel all the more keenly about this, because the matter was spoken of in the presence of several people at Grand Falls, and apparently gave them a very poor opinion of the Pay & Record Office, which in the present case is, as I have said, absolutely unwarranted.

In the matter of commissions, I have spoken to Lieut Col.Rendell, and he informs me that he has recently written to the Col.Secretary, asking to have commissions issued for yourself and other Officers who have not received theirs, and I have no doubt that same will be forthcoming in a short while.







I was placed this way myself, having called for the last cheque when in St. John's, and I asked you as a favour if you would see that the next one due would be sent on to Grand Falls. Beyond a short talk, ~~Re~~ Commission Papers and the above, I made no further complaint and I cannot see how you should view it in such a way.

I feel very sore that you should have misunderstood me, as you will see by the above that it was Mr Connors and not I who made the complaint.


