

With reference to your letter of November, 27th., to Hon. R.A. Squires, I beg to state, that final account of the late Pte. Walter Benoat, has not yet been received from the Pay & Record Office, London.

The Raymaster has informed ma, that it takes at least six months, to have a men's account finalized, after his death, as there are so many sources from which to gather the necessary information, required to complete his account.

I expect to have the accounts of those men who died in April last, very shortly, and just as soon as ere received then will be passed over to the Minister of Justice, for Administration purposes. Immediately upon receipt from him of Papers of Administration, disbursement of balance due the estates, will be made.
