

Sir:-

I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your Pte N. Boone. 992 communication of 21st inst. This men was invalided on account of wounds received whilst on active service and I understand was granted a pension on this account. He was admitted to hospital on account of a recurrence of a venereal disease, originally contracted before he went on active service. He was discharged from hospital here after a short stay, as cured, and when reattested for recruiting, it was on account of his having been invalided on account of woulds received in action, the particulars concerning venereal disease not having been disclosed. I am informed that there has been a recurrence of this disease, and in consequence, arrangements are being made to dispose of his services.
