

You will notice by a letter from the D.M.S. that Boone was ordered to report to the O.C. Headquarters on Dec. 10th. for further orders.

The recommendation of the Medical report was, "Discharge" permanently unfit."

At that time the recruiting compaign was in force and in accordance with instructions received in December, I with-held Boone's discharge until such time as I should be in structed by the O.C. Headquarters to complete same. On the same date, Dec. 10th. Boone received a payment of \$20.00 at this Office and I heard nothing more from him until I was authorized, on Feb.9th. to discharge him, which I did on Feb. 16th. giving him total amount due him at that date, namely \$199.20.


