On checking Nominal books sometime later I noted this man still carried on the Strength, and wrote the Paymaster on February 9th. 1918 and pointed same out to him.

He was accordingly discharged from the Strength with effect from February 16th. as notified O.C. Depot, in letter from Paymaster February 22nd. With reference to his Regimental Pay, as far as I can remember, his account was never carried

on Company Pay Sheets but was handled direct by the Pay Department, so that I am not in a position to say if he received his pay or not. regarding his disability, that is a matter of which the Depot authorities have no knowledge but is handled direct I understand, by the Secretary of the Pensions Board.

You will notice by a letter from the D.M.S. that Boone was ordered to report to the O.C. Headquarters on Dec. 10th. for further orders.


The recommendation of the Medical report was, "Discharge" permanently unfit.

At that time the recruiting campaign was in force and in accordance with instructions received in December, I with-held Boone's discharge until such time as I should be instructed by the O.C. Headquarters to complete same. On the same date, Dec. 10th. Boone received a payment of \$20.00 at this Office and I heard nothing more from him until I was authorized, on Feb. 9th. to discharge him, which I did on Feb. 16th. giving him total amount due him at that date, namely \$199.20.

At the present time he is drawing a Pension of \$32.00 per month which will continue for a period of six months from March, 7th.

I am in receipt of a letter, copy of which is attached, from the marginally noted man.

This man was boarded out of Convalescent Hospital on December 7th. and ordered to report to O. C. Depot on December 10th. for further orders. He was recommended for "Total" disability for three months. After two months he appears to have received neither discharge papers nor money.

Would you kindly say if his Regimental pay was continued and paid to him up to the time that his pension started as I notice his name in Daily Orders for February 16th. If he has, as his letter intimates, received no money it is rather a serious matter medically as an invalid entitled to full disability should not be in need of means of subsistence.

I shall be glad if you will cause a full enquiry to be made and let me have particulars so that wherever the hitch was, if there was any, ^{it} may not occur in future cases.

The recommendation of the Medical report was, Discharged permanently unfit.

At that time the recruiting campaign was in force and in accordance with instructions received in December, I with-held Boone's discharge until such time as I should be instructed by the O.C. Headquarters to complete same. On the same date, Dec. 10th. Boone received a payment of \$20.00 at this Office and I heard nothing more from him until I was authorized to discharge him on Feb. 9th. which I did on Feb. 16th. giving him total amount due him at that date, namely \$199.20.

At the present time he is drawing a Pension of \$32.00 per month which will continue for a period of six months from March, 7th.

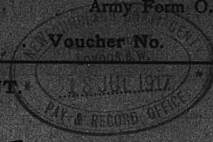
