Re 2163 Pte. Thomas Brown.

I enclose copy of correspondence which passed between Magistrate Oak of the Harbor Grace District Court and myself with regard to the marginally noted case as it explains the situation. You will note the date of that letter is August 29th.

Since that date I am glad to be able to report that the improvement hoped for is speedily taking place. Brown is now able to feed himself his bread and butter and is up for a short while each day in a chair. He is also bearing more of his body weight on his legs each day though not yet able to balance himself. To remove him from the trained care which he is getting would, in my opinion, be injudicious.

Brown is not unhappy where he is and since he can himself see the improvement has not even asked me (as he frequently did previously) about going home.

The letters above alluded to re Brown are filed in this department.

However, I am now assured that if a medical certificate is forwarded, showing that he is in need of further consideration and that special medical treatment will help him, the Pensions Board will arrange to have him brought to town for a reboard. It is possible that they will have him sent to Canada for special treatment. Possibly Mr. Archibald, before going away, spoke to you about this man's case. It is outside my province to take any action in the case, but I promised Mr. Archibald that I would do what I could. Perhaps you would be good enough to forward a medical certificate to Major Parsons, Secretary of the Board of Pensions Commissioners, concerning Brown's case.

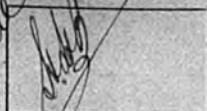

i get out but it will be some time if i have got to stay in here they told me in the hospital they were sending me home its a wonder they didnt send me to the poor house if i had known this i would have told them to keep me in England they treated me the very best over there but perhaps i will have my turn yet so if you cant come over write as soon as you can tell the girl to send me a little parcel and a bit of cake and a few of cigarettes and some matches i wont forget them when i get out thats if you cant come over and see me thats all i will say for now remember me to all friends especially Mr and Mrs Mercer iam sorry for poor Will i didnt know he was missing till tresa told me while i was in the general hospital we were such good friends i hope there will be some news from him soon

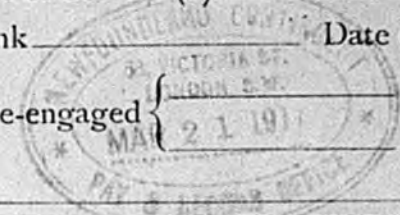
