

With reference to this man, who has been brought here to-day in charge of P. C. Chas. Woolette. The facts as I understand them are, that Bulgin whilst on furlough from B. E. F. was admitted to Military Hospital, Warlingham, was discharged 18/1/18, and sent to the Regimental Depot, Winchester, for 7 days light duty as recommended by the M. C. Hospital. C. C. Depot being required to send Bulgin to report to this Office 25/1/18, to be returned to his unit B. E. F. Apparently he did not get a pass from the Depot, Winchester, to this Office, only a Railway arrant.


