I enlisted in the Royal Naval Reserve  
on the 5<sup>th</sup> of November 1914 as  
Seaman at Seaman's rate of pay.  
On arrival at Falmouth November 20<sup>th</sup>  
I was transferred to the Engineer's  
Branch as a Stoker at Stoker's rate of  
pay namely two shillings and one  
penny per day.

I received my discharge on the 17<sup>th</sup> of  
April 1916 and re-enlisted in the  
Newfoundland Regiment September 15<sup>th</sup>  
1916.

Reserve rate of pay has been increased to equal that of the Newfoundland Regiment dating back to a Reservist's date of enlistment:-

I have met several men whose case is exactly similar to mine and who have received this increased pay. Would you kindly take the matter up with the Naval authorities and ascertain if this money is really due me.
