

Dear Sir:—

Mrs Mary Baravan, of Bay Roberts, sent you a message some time ago, expressing the wish that her son Corporal Allan Baravan, 2393, 13. Platoon, D. Company, 1st W. Field, Reg., who is now in Germany, be discharged. Permit me to say, that if you can see your way clear to have this man discharged, you will be doing a favour to one who has made a noble sacrifice for the Empire. Mrs Baravan is nearly 70 years old. She has two sons in the army, one is in France, the other is now in Germany. She is living alone, and at her age this is certainly a hardship in the winter season. She has never once complained of this while the war was in progress, but now the war is over, she would

like to have one of them home with  
her, so that she may not be compelled  
to live a life of loneliness, in her  
old days.

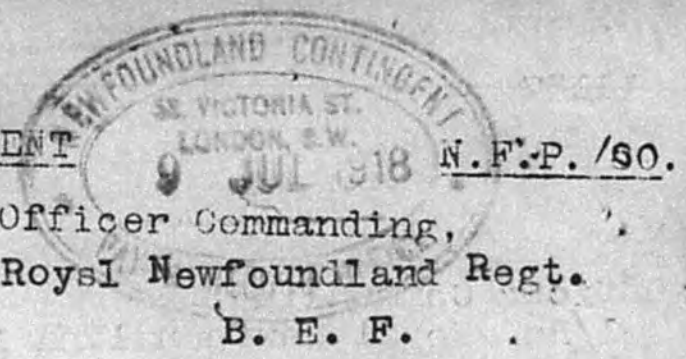
