Dear Sir:

I desire to bring under your notice the fact that I am the owner with others of a cod trap which we operate in the waters of Witless Bay. I secured a fairly good voyage of fish but none of it has as yet been cured. The fish is in salt bulk and in order to be of any value it must be cured and dried. My trap is still in the water and unless I am enabled to remove it speedily it will be lost.

I have been called up under the Military Service Act and have been enlisted as a member of the Regiment. I would ask that sufficient leave be granted me to enable me to fix up my affairs and to cure the fish which unless attended to must be a total loss. I have no one to do the work for me; my father is aged 63 years and is sick while my only brother aged 26 years is mentally defective. I might add that I am in debt to the extent of \$250 for expenses incurred in connection with the fishery and have no prospect of paying same unless I can cure my fish.

I feel assured that the military authorities have no desire to cause me and those dependent upon me any unnecessary hardship, and that they will grant me such leave as will enable me to cure the produce of the voyage.

Dear Sir:

On behalf of my son Arthur Carew of Witless Bay, I beg to bring under your notice the fact that he with others are the owners of a cod trap which they have been operating in the waters of Witless Bay and have secured a fairly good voyage of fish. The twine of the trap has been taken in but the heavy gear connected with it is still in the waters of Witless Bay. The fish caught is now in salt bulk and in order that it may be of any value it must be cured and dried.

I would therefore ask that my son be given leave of absence in order that the work of curing and drying the product of the voyage may be undertaken by him. As this will take a considerable time, I would ask that his leave be extended as long as possible under the circumstances. My son has incurred considerable financial obligations in connection with the fishery. He owes something over two hundred dollars. This sum cannot be paid unless my son be given an opportunity to ~~catch his fish~~ ~~and~~ ~~together~~ with the other members of my family are partially dependent upon ~~for~~ my son for support. Unless we can obtain his help, it will be impossible for us to cure our fish.

I would therefore request the Military authorities to take my case into their most favourable consideration and to grant such leave of absence to my son as will enable him to cure the produce of the voyage.
