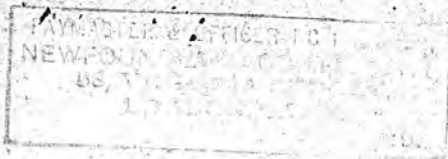

Dear Sir:-

I enclose you letter just received from the Militia Department. The money was promptly forwarded and the cause of the delay is being investigated.

I sincerely regret the annoyance caused you, but as you will observe, no blame can attach to the local services, so far as the despatch of the money is concerned. The failure to answer your telegrams is inexcusable and it is needless to say that your letter was the first intimation that I had of the matter, nor was the Money Order Superintendent aware that reply had not been made. The matter had been referred to the Militia Department and their reply awaited. This is no excuse, simply an unsatisfactory explanation of what happened. As I promised you in my telegram I attended to the matter personally this morning and received the prompt reply which I now forward.

I am writing a few lines on behalf of my son Malcolm G. Chambers, now serving in the trenches in France. I am asking if he could not be spared from the trenches, as he is not yet 17 years of age, he was only 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ years when he volunteered he wanted to go so badly and thought it his duty, but we did not think he would be sent to the trenches, we live in a small little settlement, and all our young men went the same time he did, and Malcolm is the only one spared from injuries so far, all the others have been reported as killed, wounded or missing, Now I hope I am not doing wrong by asking if anything could be done, he was at the base for three months with a bad knee and we are heartbroken to think of so young a boy to have to face such horrors. I am asking in the name of God and man that he may be kept behind the lines, it is a mother pleading for her son.
