Above named soldier was accidentally wounded by the discharge of a rifle at Cape Race on the 24th inst. I have investigated into the matter and find ~~that~~ from one of the witnesses, that another private was unloading his rifle when he accidentally discharged it, and the bullet struck Pte. Chator in the Chest.

I telegraphed Corporal Collins, N.C.O. i/c Guard, to send in written report and to communicate with the nearest doctor to have the man seen to. He secured the services of Dr. Giovannetti, Trepassey.

Private Chator is now in Barracks Hospital; his wound is not serious.

I enclose Dr. Giovannetti's bill for services rendered.

In order to try and lessen the danger of these accidental discharges of firearms, I have sent copies of an order to all N.C.O's i/c Guards to the effect that Rifles are not to be loaded under any circumstance whatsoever except in cases of urgent necessity, and I have made the N.C.O. responsible to see that this order is carried out.
