I am given to understand that the allotment of 343 Private Lawrence Clare has been stopped. Private Clare was killed on October 12th, 1916. His Allottee was his stepsister, Mrs. John Meaney, 342 Water Street West. I am given to understand that the Allottee however was not the beneficiary of the allotment; that she was merely trustee of it, the money being used for the support and schooling of May Clare, sister of the deceased; a delicate girl of about 15 or 16 years.

I should be glad if you would look into the matter and see if there are any merits in the claim of the sister, May Clare.
