Dear Sirs: -

I must inform you that No. 3643 Pte. George Clark who is now with 2/1st Nfld Regt., D. Cov. at Brussell Street, Ayr, enlisted against my consent and he is also under age (as I am enclosing his Baptism Certificate so you may see it plainly). Now I would like to know if he could be kept from the firing line until he came of age. Had I known I could have stopped him I would have done so until he came of age to enlist then he could have had my consent. He was sixteen years and five months when he enlisted and he knew his mothers wish for him to stay until he became of age but he would not obey my wish. If there is anything he can do for King and Country I would be willing for him to do so until he came of age to go to the firing line. He has a brother R.N.R. serving in the Navy since the beginning of war. Please notify me if anything can be done to keep him from the firing line.


