Your letter of January 26th. was received after the regulations governing Post Discharge Pay were superseded by those concerning war Service Gratuity, and reply has been dobayed on account of the time required to make the necessary calculations of the "er Service Gratuity.

Dear Sir Patrick,

The bearer, 1933 Pte. S. Clarke, informs me that he was discharged and pensioned in May 1917: his pension being assessed at \$8 per month. Since then he made one trip, last summer, in a fishing schooner and was occupied for one month, but he had to give up this employment as he was not able to perform the work. He subsequently secured employment with Mr. S.E. Garland, Stationer in this city, and worked there for one month and a half, when he had to give up this employment also owing to his physical condition.

He informs me that his present condition of health renders him absolutely unable to work and the amount of his pensionals not sufficient to keep himself and his wife from starvation.

I commend this men's case to your immediate consideration as, from appearances, he is in poor shape and something further should be done for him if he is in the condition which he represents himself to be. I presume the proper course would be to have him again boarded to ascertain his present disability.


