Dear Sir:-

I beg to make application for subsistence allowance from the time I was taken on as a drummer, up to the time of my enlistment Feby. 3/17.

I was employed as a drummer around the 15th of April. 1916 at .50¢ per day, but received no board allowance absolutly.

We entered barracks at the Princes Rink sometime near the 1st to the 15th of May.

We left barracks around the end of Sept to the 10 of Oct. 1916.

Enlisted the 3rd of Feby 1917.

After I enlisted more drummers were taken on at the same rate of pay but were given a board allowance of 6.00 per week, and I only got knowledge of that three weeks ago from a drummer of the Regt who like myself was only an employeé of the Regt. After a time the pay went to .75¢ per day consequently the board allowance was cut out.

The dates which I give you possibly are not correct but anyway they will give you some idea so that you will not have much trouble in

looking up this affair.

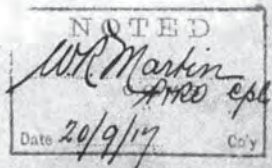
