

Dear Madam,

I am just in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, asking whether it is possible for you to send some tobacco and tinned food to your son, who is a prisoner in Germany. In reply, I would say that this is not possible, and the matter was set forth fully in a letter which was published in the daily papers by the Minister of Militia. The Central Committee in London arranges for the forwarding to your son of three parcels of food each fortnight, and they also supply him with tobacco. There is, therefore, no necessity for your sending any of such goods, and, in fact, the transmission of such parcels would not be allowed.

You may, however, rest content that he is being well looked after, and that in due time he will be returned to you again.

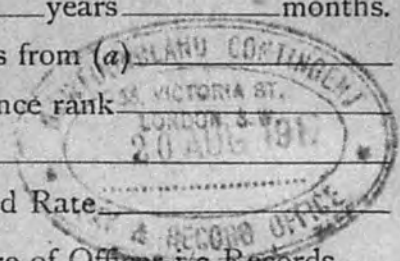

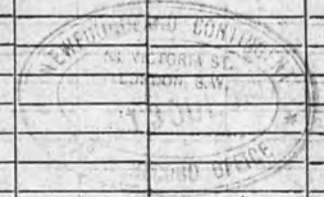
