





Woods (who were Prisoners of War for a considerable time) 2749 L/C. F. A. Janes, B. Churchill and myself were promised that augumentation pay would be granted us so that we would receive the same rate as a private

I, with the others, embarked from Newfoundland 27/IO/I5, and with the exception of Churchill (who failed to pass the Medical examination in

C.R. 2147 St. John's, June 18th, 1919. A.E. Hickman, Meq., M.H.A., Ninister of Militia. Dept. of Militia. In response to a call from the Imperial army for men trained in the St. John's Amblance Brigade, or interested in medicine, we the undersigned, Non. Com. Officers and men offered our services, and were drafted to England with "6" Company of our Regiment in October 1915. The Newfoundland Government paid our passages, and gave us the status of a Newfoundland soldier. On arriving in London, we were enhisted in the Imperial Royal Army Medical Corps, and received 1/6 por day pay. The money was not sufficient for our needs, and we received on an average from home \$300.00 each. The Royal Baral Reserve had the Imperial rate pay sugmented to bring it up to the pay of the soldier in the Regiment. We are convinced that our claims in a similar one, that we were doing our duty to our country and Empire as well as the soldiers in our Regiment and the sailors in the Royal Neval Reserve, and so we sail that our pay be sugmented to make it equal to the rate of the Royal Revioundland Regiment and the Royal Naval Reserve, for the period of time we served in the Imperial forces. Three of us served for 9 months with medical corps, and one for 14 months, after which we were all transferred to our own Regiment, and all of us have seen service in the field for 18 months or longer. Two of us were prisoners of war, one for one year, and the other for 1 year and 8 months. The remaining two were invalided to England due to wounds receive in action. We were all College Students and are having difficulty in financing ourselves to meet our College expenses. We had all matriculated, and were accepted at various Colleges, and through our foregoing consent to overseas, our expenses have now been increased approximately 50% which means an increase in our expenses from \$1500.00 to \$1500.00. We feel. sure that you will readily see and appreciate the facts which we bring sure that you will resulty see and appreciate the rasts which we crims fore you. Our claim is just. We as stidents, have made greater ears than any other section of the Community, and the money we are now and for, if granted is to be pent on education, so that we may fit ourse, the better to advance and assist in the reconstruction nessessitated by domands of four years of War.
