May it please Your Excellency:

I humbly present for Your Excellency's consideration the circumstances of myself and my family.

My only son, John Crawley, aged twenty-three years, was an Electrician at Bell Island, receiving about \$50.00 per month. He has recently enlisted but I am not sure that he has yet been sworn in. He was our only support. All my other children are in the States and away from me, and there is no one now left but myself and my husband. My husband is seventy six years of age and is not in good health and practically beyond his labour. I am myself also very sickly and I am crippled.

In the light of these circumstances, whilst I should wish to do my part as a mother, may I ask that Your Excellency would excuse my boy from service as his going to War would only mean distress for his father and mother.
