With reference to your C.L.30/18 of 12/8/18; it is noted that you recommend that above named Officer Cadet be relegated to his unit.

The above named Cadet was recommended for return to his unit under War Office instruction which state that Cadets who have been in hospital beyond a certain period should be so returned to their units.

I reported the matter to the O.C.2nd.Bn.Royal Nfld.Reg't. and quote his remarks -

This rule has been strictly adhered to in the case of all Cadets up to date, and I do not think it would be fair to make an exception in this case, especially in view of the nature of his indisposition.

"If possible I should be glad if further opportunity could be given to CSM.Daniels to qualify as an officer. He has done very good work in the past and was one of the most promising N.C.Os.I have recommended for admission to a Cadet Battalion."
