On a list of estates of deceased soldiers sent to this Office some time in 1917, we find the name of S. Dawe, and he is posted as having "Died of Wounds on the 28/4/17. His next of kin is given as "Robert Dawe, 83 McFarlane St., Father," and the allottee as "Louisa Dawe, 70 George Street, Wife," the amount to the credit of his estate being \$38.24. We sent out the usual notice to Louisa Dawe and received no response, but in answer to the second notice she called at this Office, and stated that her husband was alive, but that he was in the Penitentiary at St. John's. An examination of the records of the Penitentiary showed that he was sent there by F. J. Morris, K.C., Judge of the Central District Court, on the 19th of March, 1919, for a period of one year for the offence of larceny. I am sending you this for your information.

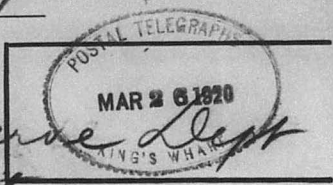

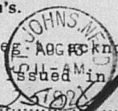
