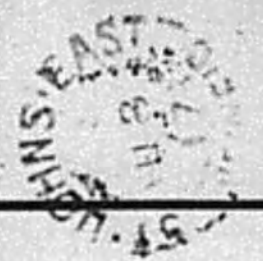



I beg to inform you that we this Department has received the consent of the father of the above named soldier (K.W. Dean, 352 Main St. Bradford Mass. father) to treat his grave as a War Grave.
