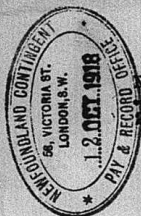

It is pleasing to hear from you that Lieut. Edwards makes such an efficient Quarter Master; and it is fully understood that it would be rather difficult to dispense with his services.


Please inform if you have in mind the posting of the returned officer to the position of Quarter Master, with a view to relieving Lieut. Edwards for executive work.
