



I had turned round to go across to the next room (Orderly Room) to see to the fir there when I heard an explosion and heard Corpl Dunn and Pte. Payne sing out as they had both been hit. I am sure there was nothing in the paper I placed on the fire. It was a piece of wrapping paper from a parcel.


