We have received the eligibility forms returned by you regarding replacement of service medals earned by members of your family during the First World War.


Enclosed is a statement of the replacement cost for the British War Medal awarded to your late father.

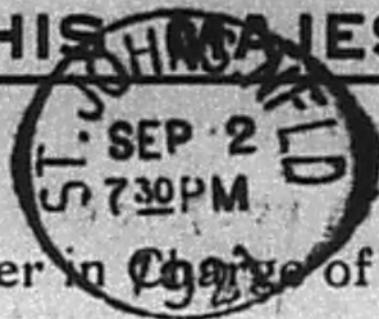
