Replying to your letter of Feb. 22nd., I have to inform you that before you can be demobilized it is necessary that you be medically examined. I enclose herewith a form used for that purpose and if you can have a Doctor examine you and sign this certificate and return it to me, it will not be necessary for you to return to St. John's. Your discharge can then be carried out by mail. If however, owing to your having contracted a disability while on service he is unable to give you this certificate, it will be necessary for you to return to St. John's at the expiration of your leave to go before the Standing Medical Board.

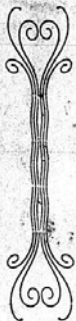
