Reference letter Spl 10274 d 23 Aug. 50 addressed to Director of War Service Records, D V A., which has been passed to this Directorate for reply.

Regimental and Pay Documents reveal that one Michael Joseph EVANS enlisted in the Royal Newfoundland Regiment on the 2nd January 1915 and served overseas, was returned to Newfoundland and discharged effective 12th September 1916, with the rank of Private. During this service he was paid \$1.00 per diem plus 10 cents field allowance. No Separation Allowance in payment he being single.

He re-enlisted under his original regimental number with the Royal Newfoundland Regiment on the 3rd August 1918 and served until the 5th May 1919. He held the rank of private from 3rd August 1918 until 19th January 1919 and was paid \$1.00 per diem plus 10 cents field allowance. Effective the 20th January 1919 he was promoted to the rank of Corporal and was paid \$1.10 per diem plus 10 cents field allowance.

He was married 25th November 1917 and on his re-enlistment was paid Separation Allowance of \$20.00 per month effective 1st November 1918 until date of discharge.

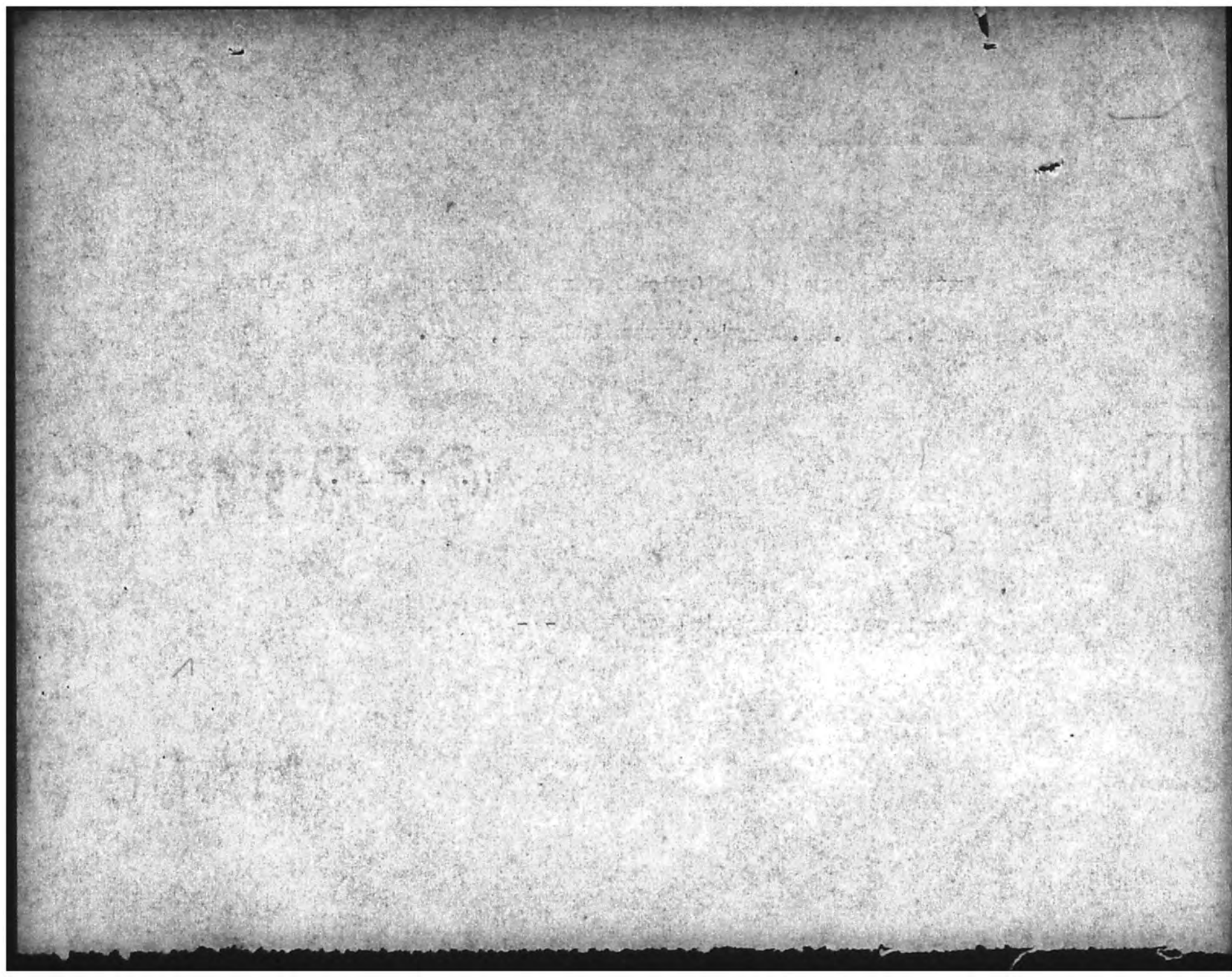


