We have no record of what medals he received or was entitled to; however, you should write to:

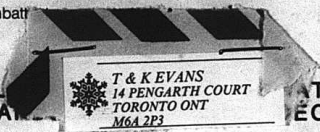

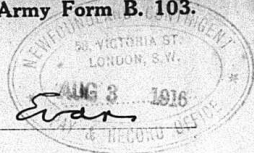



May we explain that according to our regulations, access to records or release of personal information relating to an individual is not permitted without the written consent of the individual concerned. In the event that the individual has been dead for less than 20 years, limited information may be released to members of the immediate family, if proof of death (death certificate, obituary notice, etc.) and proof of relationship (baptismal certificate, marriage certificate or any other document that clearly demonstrates the relationship) are provided. 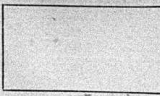

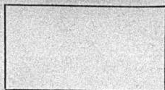
