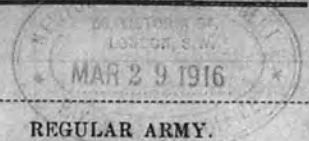



I have the honour to submit the following report on No. 1260, Pte. Fillier, who returned 'time expired' under Major Carty on May 11th.

Pte. Fillier was attested in the Newfoundland Regmt., on March 17th. 1915. He proceeded Overseas with 'E' Company of the 2nd. Battalion, and was transferred to 'C' Company of the 1st. Battalion at Stobbs Camp. He went to Gallipoli with the 1st. Battalion, and was admitted at Wandsworth Hospital Jany. 9th. 1916, suffering from Debility. He was discharged from the hospital on March 23rd. 1916, and was granted ten days furlough. He then reported at Ayr, and remained at that Depot, up to the 20th. day of April 1917, on which date he was discharged as 'time expired'. He was then returned to St. John's under Major Carty, arriving here May 11th.
