Some of the orderlies have been taken from the Corp's Squad and given duties inside, around the Office. The increased rates have been given them and we are obliged to go on as usual.

Now Sir, we consider here, an injustice has been done, which we feel you will see adjusted when properly brought to your notice, we feel no distinction should have been made but rather all should be treated alike.
