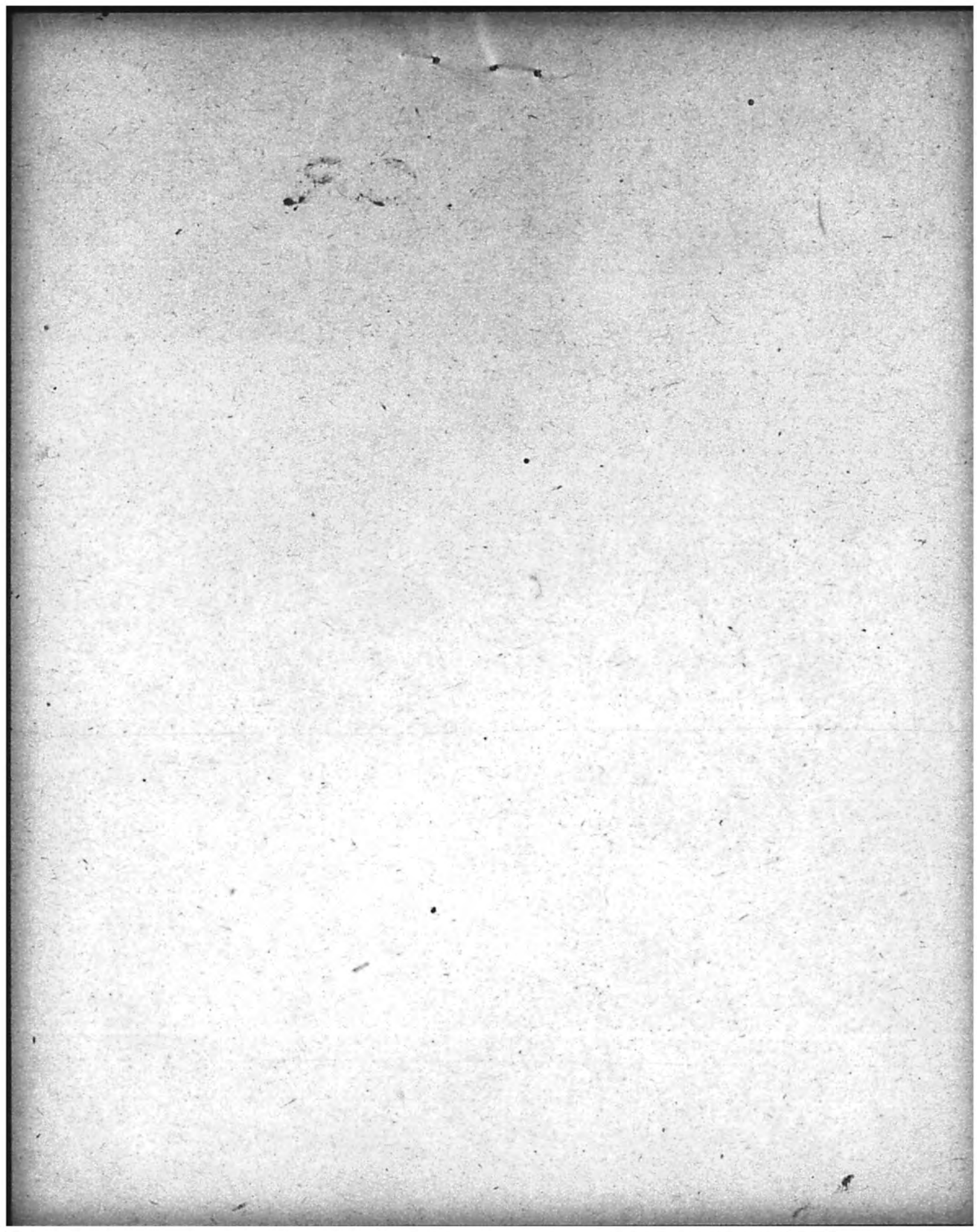



Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 6th instant, I beg to say that, under existing regulations, the sending of private parcels to prisoners of war in Germany, except officers, is not permitted by the Germany Authorities. The Newfoundland War Contingent Association of London has undertaken to see that each prisoner receives adequate supplies of food and clothing and to that end three parcels are sent by them to each man every fortnight. Friends of prisoners are, however, permitted to send letters to them but such letters should always be addressed in care of the Nfld. Pay and Record Office, 58 Victoria St., London, S.W. Sums of money can also be sent through the same channel.

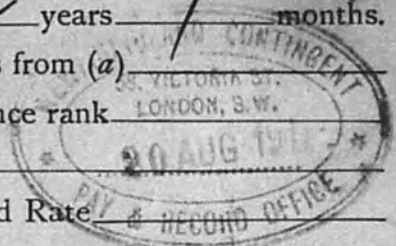
