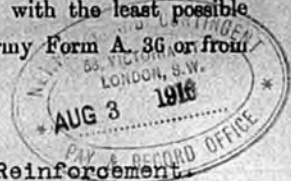

Now Sir i told him i didnt think my poor boy had any better privilage than the other ^{poor} boys had of getting all there money due them on the other side whose parents have had there poor boys liability money sent them for months ago why am i left out i had a letter from the militia department a little later in the same month saying they where waiting letters of administration before making payment now that is about six months ago that is quite a while to be waiting, remember he was no slacker that died in the first of July drive

Now Sir i am going to appeal to you for satisfaction i know it is ⁱⁿ your power you being our member and i suppose likely to be gain. will you kindly let me know why i am not paid or whose fault it is. my poor boys money havent been sent me i want all that belongs to him by so doing you will oblige i dont reckon you will loose by it. i will be waiting your reply or what you can do for me about the same
