I find on looking into this case that the husband is allotting 50¢ per day roughly \$30. per month to his wife and further that Separation Allowance \$20. per month has been current since 1st, Sept. I notice that Gillett makes a reference in his letter to an allowance for his wife and one child. He is apparently ~~misinformed~~ concerning allowance for the later as no such an allowance is in operation. An allowance is payable to a child only in cases where the wife is dead or when a soldier is killed or dies, when a pension is payable to each child. I am returning the marriage certificate herewith.

Lenard is in the best of health but his arm still troubles him a bit his thumb and two fingers useless. I am glad to know that you are recovering and hope you will soon be about again. I am returning Mrs Gillett's letter.
