Mrs. Clarke was in receipt of a separation allowance but upon her death it was discontinued.

As there is no one but Mrs Clarke's sister to take care of the sister of Pte. Gladney <sup>the girl</sup> that the separation allowance formerly paid to the mother should now be paid to the support of the sister.

If this is not done there is no other alternative but to make application to the Poor Commissioner to have this demented girl sent to the Poor Asylum.

We think that you will agree with us that this is not a desirable thing to do, considering that the brother of this girl has been on active service overseas since the early days of the war.
