- 1st. Medical Board 23/5/17. Rec. 3 mos. furlough.
- 2nd. do 28/8/17. Rec. for discharge.

Since last Board no action has been taken, and as I understand men kept on Regimental Strength pending discharge were available for recruiting purposes, I gave his name to Mr. Turner some time ago. I mention this in case he has been employed in the meantime.

As this man is evidently in a poor state of health I thought it best to bring the matter before your notice. He also seems under a misapprehension regarding his pay, thinking it ceased when he was recommended for discharge.
