The information that I can give you from the records is, I am afraid,very meagre. The Grave sites records were taken to London by Lt.Col.Hangle when he was last here,and have not been returned.

The following are the only entries that I can find in the individual files,viz.,

Lt.Stanley Goodyear, buried just north of Langemarck,
(Report Langemarck,80-1)

O.Ray.Goodyear, originally buried at Gueudecourt,
Body removed to Bancourt Military Cemetery,~~just~~
two miles east of Bapaume.

Should the information be required in connection with proposed visit to the cemeteries,full details can be obtained at the Office of the High Commissioner,London.

Sick Leave, Officers

I have the honour to enclose copy of "B.2" relating to 2/Lt. H.K. Goodyear.

In the ordinary course, this notification should arrive at St. John's before expiry of his leave, 21/11/18, and it would be advisable to telegraph if he is not able to report to the Army Medical Authorities in time.

I have had several enquiries from the War Office regarding officers who have not reported at the proper time. As a matter of regulation they should not leave this Country without permission. In some instances officers have left, and just before sailing have left their War Office notifications at this office to be dealt with, which is not in order and may lead to trouble, since officers are responsible to the Medical Authorities until finally boarded.

In the case of Lt. F. Knight, notification by telegraph and otherwise from H.Q., St. John's, has been transmitted to the War Office, and the practice will be continued.

With the object of avoiding difficulties in the future, I have written to the O.C. 2nd Bn. and to the War Office, see annexures.

It was understood that a reply from the latter would have been furnished by return, but so far it has not arrived. Meanwhile it is desirable to advise you with regard to 2/Lt. Goodyear.



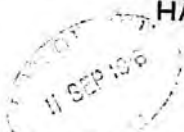



Issue of travelling or Field Allowance to Officers moving with Troops at night.

1. If the Officers spend the night in bivouac, in public halls, or empty buildings or otherwise, under conditions in which Field Allowance would be admissible if they were stationed in the place, Field Allowance is admissible for Officers not on consolidated pay.

2. If they are accommodated in furnished public quarters no Field or Travelling Allowance is Admissible.

3. 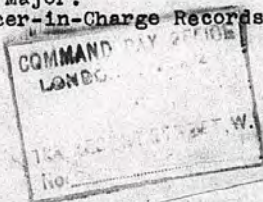

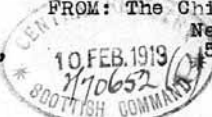


