London Gazette, May 14th 1919

Action Date, September 29th 1918 – Keiberg Ridge

On the morning of September 29th 1918, when his platoon was held up by an enemy machine gun firing from a covered position, he crawled 100 yards in front, killed the machine gun crew, thus enabling the platoon to advance.
