





I am to state that a cable message has been received from the Department of Militia in St. John's to the effect that your repatriation to Newfoundland at the expense of the Government cannot be authorised. From this you will see that it is impossible to provide free passages for yourself and your wife to Newfoundland.

If you are still intending to go home and have your operation performed in St. John's rather than in Edinburgh, there is a steamer sailing from Liverpool on the 28th of this month and application for passage should be made personally by you to Messra. Furness, Withy & Co., Ltd., Royal Liver Buildings, Liverpool.

I am to point out that there are probably greater facilities in Edinburgh for the surgical treatment you require than in St. John's at the present time, and you should take this matter into consideration before definitely applying for passages to return home.

Prior to his leaving for active Service he contracted Pheumatism at Salisbury Plains, which troubled him exceedingly all through the Campaign. Oct Gallipoli he was stricken down, with Dysentry and oralaria, and spent four months in hospital in & gypt. Ib & was however able to rejoin his Regiment, before leaving & gypt, and later proceeded with them to France. He served with them there up to July first, when in that battle he was. wounded. One of the wounds received rendered it necessary, for him do have an operation performed; some three months, after his arrival home. The Operation in itself was successful; but owing to the Rheumatism contracted as stated above The wound is still instable and painful, and according to her Leigan, who operated on him it is doubly of he can do more than light bluty for a long time to come.

By his bast medical Board, he was granted Lwo months furlough, which serminates on march 44/4.
