(\$30) for a suit of ~~clothes~~ the cap
collar and tie; and thirty dollars
(\$30) for an overcoat.

Well Sir, as to those who have
served, that applies to me

and I should like to know when I am going to get it.

I don't know if men in my case would have to put in claims for such allowances or not, but I shouldn't think we would, as the officials in the Pay & Record Office know who is who.

I should also like to write a few lines concerning the Pension that I have received since being discharged. I have received the sum of sixteen dollars (\$16) per month, which if I smoked, I don't suppose it would pay for my cigarettes. Now this sixteen dollar (\$16) is insufficient for any fellow

that is disabled to work, it is true I am not deficient of either arms or legs, but I am wounded in the chest and have got metal still in me and it affects my General health much more than if I were wounded in arms or legs.

If I and other fellows in my case didn't happen to have a home and parents to go to, or money to fall back on, what would we do on being discharged? where would we get board and lodging much less other necessities for sixteen dollars per month? I am hoping to get better in time, but until then I will not be fit for work, you

may be sure Sir, I shall be
glad when that day comes
for nothing is so tiresome
as doing nothing.
