Dear Sir:-

Your letter of enquiry dated Feb. 20th, and concerning Samuel Greenslade, is hereby acknowledged.

If this is the man who served in the Royal Newfoundland Regiment as No. 3289, I can state his military record, though he is not known beyond his military service.

He enlisted on 1st. December, 1916, (aged 19 years 3 months) and was demobilised on 27th March 1919, having served 2 Years 117 days. His conduct during that period was Excellent. He was awarded the Distinguished Conduct Medal for conspicuous bravery and devotion to duty when-

"On the 14th. October 1918, during the attack from Ledgehem towards Lys, this man's section was temporarily held up by the enemy Machine Gun and Snipers firing from a farm house. On his own initiative Pte. Greenslade dashed forward with his Lewis Gun and carrier of ammunition, firing from his shoulder and hip until he got to a position well round to the left flank. As he advanced, he was heavily fired on by the hostile M.G. and the snipers. He got his gun into position and opened fire with his gun through the windows of the farm house. Under cover of this fire, his section advanced, captured the M.G. and 12 prisoners. Pte. Greenslade's quick action and dash were worthy of great praise." (Extract from the London Gazette

He was promoted Lance Corporal on 9th November 1918.

I beg to quote hereunder the details of the deed for which your son, #3289 Lance Corporal S. Greenslade was awarded the DISTINGUISHED CONDUCT MEDAL. Taken from the supplement to the London Gazette.

" For conspicuous bravery and devotion to duty. On the 14th. October 1918, during the attack from LEDSGHAM towards LYS, this man's section was temporarily held up by the enemy Machine Gun and Snipers firing from a farm house. On his own initiative Pte. Greenslade dashed forward with his Lewis Gun and carrier of ammunition, firing from his shoulder and hip until he got to a position well round to the left flank. As he advanced, he was heavily fired on by the hostile M. G. and the snipers. He got his gun into position and opened fire with his gun through the windows of the farm house. Under cover of this fire, his section advanced, captured the M. G. and 12 Prisoners. Pte. Greenslade's quick action and dash were worthy of great praise
