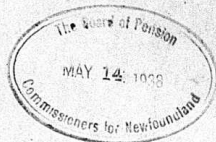

My husband, William Henry Hamilton, enlisted with the Newfoundland Forces during the War and served Overseas for a period of about four years.

The above ex-soldier died in New York on September 4th, 1937 and, as the attending Physicians, during the period of his illness previous to death, namely five years, oft times expressed it as being their opinion that his death was due to gassing Overseas, I am desirous of making application for Pension on account of his death. For this reason, I shall be obliged if you will write sending copies of any documental evidence which may be available from his file to assist me in promoting my claim. We were married on the 4th., day of July, 1927 at Saint John, New Brunswick.

As the representatives of ex-soldiers here are not very clear with respect to the Soldier's Pension Laws and Regulations of Newfoundland, I would be greatly obliged if you could, when replying, let me know whether there is a Branch of the British Empire Service League at St. John's into whose hands I could place the promotion of my claim for Pension.

Upon receipt of your communication of March 14th, we again contacted the widow of the above former serviceman, and have now ascertained that this deceased veteran's brother, Erellian Hamilton, is at the present time a resident of Tack's Beach, Placentia Bay, Newfoundland, and verification of the service of his brother, the above named man, could be furnished by him.

However, the veteran's widow is sure that the record which you identified as William Henry Hamilton is that of her husband. She informs us she has no War Medals or any papers which would serve as identification, but the above named veteran was born at sea between Newfoundland and the United States and his father, Robert Hamilton, was a resident of Tack's Beach, Placentia Bay, Newfoundland.

If this data is sufficient to enable you to issue a certificate of the military service of the above deceased veteran, it would be very much appreciated.

Re - William Henry Hamilton.

Your letter of the 21st. ult. addressed to the Secty. Department of Defense has been referred to this Department for attention.

I have searched carefully the records of the Royal Nfld. Regt. and find that one William Hamilton enlisted December 11th. 1916 and served overseas with the Royal Nfld. Regt. - His father's name was Robert Hamilton of Task's Beach, Placentia Bay, Nfld. The place of birth of the deceased is not shown, but his attestation papers state that he was a British subject.

If it is possible, the widow of this veteran should furnish something more substantial in the way of identification, for instance the War Medals of the deceased, discharge badge or papers. I would suggest that she be requested to search very carefully through her husband's effects with the object of dis-  
covering

some more tangible means of identification. You can, I am sure, appreciate the need for care in issuing certificates of military services where identification is uncertain.

We shall be glad to furnish you with any further information in this connection.



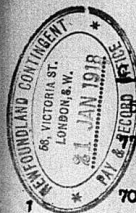

## Cable Connection with all the World

### All Messages Sent are Subject to the Following Conditions:

The Management may decline to forward the Message, though it has been received for transmission; but in case of so doing shall refund to the Sender the amount paid for its transmission.

In case the Message shall never reach its destination by reason of any neglect or default of the N. P. T. or its Servants whilst the Message remains under the control of the N. P. T., they will refund the amount paid by the Sender for such Message.

The N. P. T. shall not be liable to make compensation beyond the amount refunded as above for any loss, injury, or damage arising or resulting from the non-transmission or non-delivery of the Message, or delay or error in the transmission or delivery thereof, howsoever such transmission, non-delivery, delay, or error shall have occurred.

The control of the N. P. T. over the Message shall be deemed to have entirely ceased for the purposes of these Conditions at any point where, in the course of the transit of the Message to its destination, it may be entrusted by the N.
