I wish to make application for "Blue Puttee" leave money on these grounds:- On discharge from Wandsworth Hospital I was recommended for 3 mos. complete rest. On arrival at the depot at Ayr, I was asked by the M.O. in charge to help out the Corp. in charge there as one of the staff was at Durin with a company for rifle practice. After being there about three weeks I was taken sick again and was recommended for home. Left Ayr on the 27th Oct./16 and arrived home Nov 11th/16. Reported to Headquarters the same date. Major's Montgomerie the M.O. in charge at that time told me that there was nothing about leave on my papers and that I would have to work in the Med. Dept. Reported every week for about three weeks. and was told that I could not be given any leave to go out of town because he might send for me at any moment. Went to work with Dr. McPherson in the D. M. S. Office, Colonial Bldg. but took sick again and left just before Christmas. Had a medical Board about the 3rd of Jan. and was told to report for duty at the C.L. 15. Amnony on Jan 5th/17. Remained at the Amnony until Aug 15th/17 when transferred to M. I. D. Hospital. and remained there until relieved by C. S. M. Goolby in July/18 without one day's leave. Transferred from M. I. D. Hosp. to Princess st. On duty there until transferred to Empire Barracks Hosp. on duty there until destroyed by fire and was then transferred to Emergency Hosp. (Seamans. Institute) Was on duty at the time the (Blue Puttees) were on leave and practically ever since. If there was any leave given me ~~then~~ since coming to M. I. D. it was for sickness and ordered by a M.O.

The marginally noted N. C. O. was posted in Part 11 Daily Orders of August 18th., 1917, to be "Acting Sergeant from August 17th., 1917".

It seems that he has been all along under the impression that his rank was full rank and all communications have been addressed to him as "Sergeant", not as "Acting Sergeant".

What is most concerning him at present is that he was granted a separation allowance of a full Sergeant. He is now informed that as he has only "Acting" rank he should have had but \$20.00 per month, instead of \$25.00, which leaves him some \$90.00 in debt.

As this N. C. O. has done faithful and good work right through, and has been practically invalided through his work, I would strongly recommend that he be given full rank, and that the promotion be dated back to the time when he was given "acting" rank.

I am under the impression that it was for full rank that I recommended him in the first instance.

I wish to make application for proficiency pay (Unusual Disease) from the 15th August 1917 to June 1st 1919, on the following grounds.

In August 1917, I was put in charge of the Military Hospital for Infectious Diseases, and remained there until June 1918 when relieved by C.S.M. Goolby, and sent on sick leave. On my return from leave in July was transferred to the Princess Rink Hospital, and while there I had to bring the "Infectious cases for special treatment" to the M.O. at night. This was necessitated by there being no one else to do the work at that time, and also that I had to do the main hospital work by day, due to Lieut. Reeves being overseas with a draft.

I have made several applications to the M.O's then in charge, but they were given to understand by them that my case was being applied into.
