With reference to your letter of 29/11/18 (10343) addressed to the "High Commissioner for Newfoundland," it is not at present known when Pte. Hancock will proceed to Newfoundland, as he is still in France, but if you will be good enough to bring up the subject again when he is about to be repatriated (you will doubtless be in touch with him yourself), if at all possible, steps will be taken in order that your son can accompany him, although nothing definite can be promised in this respect, owing to the fact that troopships are very often reserved for troops only.

No arrangements, of course, can be made until it is known when Pte. Hancock is to be sent back.
