The reason why I am writing Sir is because I am afraid of his shyness. that he did not tell you how he is, and also how he have been.

Before he leave home two weeks ago he was nearly blind in his left eye, & he have had a tear drop in his right eye ever since he have been born, it is worst sometimes than it is others especially in winter, as water running from it burns his face, he could never leave his glasses off, as they would get worst.

And beside Sir he have had Inflammation three ~~times~~ times first when he was 14 or 15 years, the last time was two & half years ago, it comes on him very sudden. we were always very careful over him could not let him get his feet wet at all.

No matter how often he get sick or catch a cold it would sure to fall in his eyes before leaving him

Sir if I have said anything to offend you please forgive me, as I am his Mother I thought it my duty to write you concerning

the same, to satisfy my mind.
