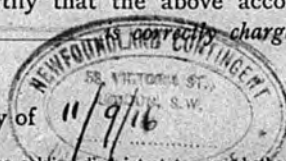

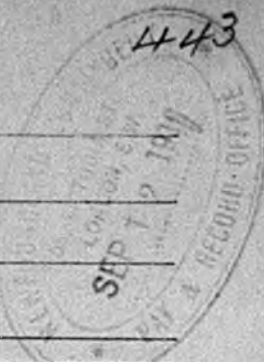

Your letter of February 4th., was received after the regulations governing Post Discharge Pay were superseded by those concerning War Service Gratuity, and reply has been delayed on account of the time required to make the necessary calculations of the War Service Gratuity.

Payments of this gratuity will commence on March 1st., 1919, and will be made in monthly instalments until such time as the amount due has been paid.

The amount due is calculated on the basis of soldier's services, and any amount paid as bonus at the time of Discharge, and Post Discharge Pay if already paid, will be deducted from the total amount of the Gratuity.

It is necessary before payment is made, that the enclosed Statutory Declaration be completed and returned to me.

As soon as it is received the first payment on account of the War Service Gratuity will be forwarded.

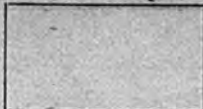

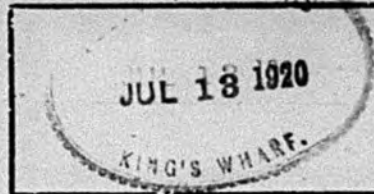
