" Referring to the list of missing men to the 1st Newfoundland Regt. published in our circular No.29. we have to-day received from the Frankfurt Red Cross the intimation that J.J. Healey 2748. 1st Newfoundland Regt. is a prisoner at the camp of Munster 3, having been taken prisoner at Hais on the 14th April 1917. His health is satisfactory and he last wrote home on the 14th October 1917."



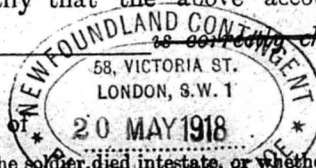

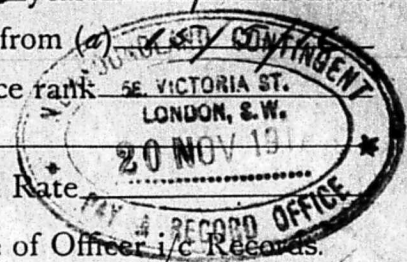
